Subject: - Introducing new features on Kaushal Bharat from 1st January 2024-reg.

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, this is to inform you that effective from **1st January 2024**, following new features are going to be made live on Kaushal Bharat-

1. In the current system, while creating a batch, PIA can select the batch start date between the Current Date and 9 days prior to Current Date. This hampers the realtime initiation of batch and capturing of required attendance from day 1 of training. Hence, new feature of batch scheduler is being introduced, in Batch Creation module through which PIA can select the batch start date from Current Date to Current Date + 29 days only for creating a batch.

Provision for making entries of first nine days as back dated entry is being removed and only current & future dates shall be available on date calendar for scheduling/planning. All the batches must be created online on Kaushal Bharat prior to commencement of the batches and duly approved by SRLM on or before the Batch Freeze Date. No changes in the composition of the batch shall be allowed other than declaring candidate drop out after the Batch Freeze Date.

2. Onboarding of PIAs and Candidates on Rural Skills Attendance portal (<https://central.ruralskillattendance.ac.in/>) shall be integrated with Kaushal Bharat portal and no manual entry of PIA and Candidate information shall be allowed into the AEBAS system, i.e., all the candidates must be enrolled in a batch on Kaushal Bharat, before enabling them for attendance in AEBAS portal.

3. As of now batches are being closed by PIAs without any approval process from SRLM / SSDM. A new feature of batch closure is being introduced on Kaushal Bharat that is batch closure request will be raised by PIAs and same will be approved by respective SRLM / SSDM. The same shall be tracked for timely closure and reporting of progress.

This issue with the approval of competent authority.
